PEOPLE AND IDEAS ON THE MOVE IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC / PESSOAS E IDEIAS EM MOVIMENTO NO ATLÂNTICO SUL / DES PERSONNES ET DES IDÉES EN MOUVEMENT DANS L'ATLANTIQUE SUD

This panel – which will be conducted in English – will examine the movement of people and ideas in the South Atlantic from the eighteenth century to the 1960s. The focus will be on Angola, Brazil and Portugal, with a tinge of Canada. Attention will be paid to the forced movement of enslaved Africans from Angola into Brazil. Within this framework, consideration will also be given to the unauthorized movement of otherwise free Africans out of Angola, the migration of free, freed, and enslaved individuals from Brazilian ports to Angola and the displacements of some of the men and women who, in the mid-nineteenth century, were responsible for the transition from slave trading to "legitimate commerce" in the South Atlantic. With the movement of people goes the movement of ideas. The panel will thus also deal with the late nineteenth century Simulambuco Treaty and its uses in and beyond the Cabinda Enclave, as well as the role of Canadian missionaries in the awakening of a nationalist consciousness in mid-twentieth century Angola.

Este painel – que será realizado em inglês – irá examinar o movimento de pessoas e ideias no Atlântico Sul, desde o século XVIII até à década de 1960. O enfoque será sobre Angola, Brasil e Portugal, com um toque sobre o Canadá. Será dada atenção ao movimento forçado de africanos escravizados de Angola para o Brasil. Neste contexto, será igualmente considerada a circulação não autorizada de africanos no entanto livres para fora de Angola, a migração de indivíduos livres, libertados e escravizados dos portos brasileiros para Angola as deslocações de alguns dos homens e mulheres que, em meados do século XIX, foram responsáveis pela transição do comércio de escravos para o "comércio legítimo" no Atlântico Sul. Com o movimento de pessoas segue também o movimento de ideias. O painel tratará assim também com o Tratado Simulambuco do final do século XIX e com os seus usos dentro e fora do Enclave de Cabinda, bem como o papel dos missionários canadenses no despertar de uma consciência nacionalista em Angola em meados do século XX.

Cet atelier – qui se déroulera en anglais – examinera la circulation des personnes et des idées dans l'Atlantique Sud du XVIII^e siècle aux années 1960. L'accent sera mis sur l'Angola, le Brésil et le Portugal, avec une touche de Canada. Une attention particulière sera accordée au mouvement forcé des Africains asservis de l'Angola vers le Brésil. Dans ce cadre, on examinera également le mouvement non autorisé d'Africains pourtant libres hors d'Angola, la migration d'individus libres, affranchis et asservis des ports brésiliens vers l'Angola, les déplacements de certains des hommes et des femmes qui, au milieu du XIX^e siècle, ont été responsables de la transition du commerce d'esclaves au "commerce légitime" dans l'Atlantique Sud. Les mouvements de personnes s'accompagnent de mouvements d'idées. L'atelier abordera donc également le Traité de Simulambuco de la fin du XIX^e siècle et ses utilisations dans et au-delà de l'enclave de Cabinda, ainsi que le rôle des missionnaires canadiens dans l'éveil d'une conscience nationaliste en Angola au milieu du XX^e siècle.
